# Volunteer Training

---

Guardians ad Litem are citizens who volunteer to represent children before the court, social service agencies and the community. Volunteers are trained and supervised by program staff, including attorneys. On average, Guardians ad Litem devote approximately 8–10 hours a month and create relationships that can make a huge impact on children's lives. To become a Guardian, you must be at least 18 years old. Guardians that are 18–21 years old will work together with an older GAL. A criminal background check will be completed on all applicants and you must complete the 30-hour pre-service training program to be certified, which includes classroom instruction and out of class assignments.
