A Guardian ad Litem is a citizen who volunteers to represent children before the court, social service agencies, and the community. The program staff works closely with volunteers as part of a team. On average, a Guardian ad Litem may devote 8-10 hours a month. Volunteers create relationships that can make a significant impact on the life of a child. To become a Guardian ad Litem, you must be at least twenty-one years old and pass a criminal background. Young adults nineteen or twenty years old may become certified and work under the guidance of and in partnership with a Guardian ad Litem twenty-one years of age or older. You must complete a pre-service training program to become certified, which includes independent study, classroom training, and field work.
